Coulson Aviation (Australia) PTY Ltd was created in 2010 to support Coulson Aviation's long-term operations and commitment to its Australian customers. It was setup as a wholly owned subsidiary of Coulson Aircrane Ltd. to provide aircraft personnel for Coulson's rotary and fixed wing aircraft operating under contract in Australia for Firefighting and offshore oil applications. Coulson Aircrane Ltd. (Port Alberni, BC) operate a Business and Quality Management System certified to ISO 9001:2015 + AS9100D for the manufacturing of parts and assemblies, including post-delivery support.

PRIMARY DUTIES:

- Operate fuel transport equipment to deliver Jet-A petroleum products to our rotary and fixed wing aircraft in the field of operations.
- Follow an assigned schedule on route when dispatched to fires. Consult with the Chief Pilot, Mechanic Crew Chief, and Ground Fleet Manager regarding suggested changes to route, schedules, and policies and promptly report any delays or irregularities to the schedule.
- Ensure the cleanliness and mechanics of all ground service equipment.
- Perform all pre and post trip inspections, and accurately report findings.
- Maintain all trip documentation, including driver records and fuel delivery to aircraft
- Perform scheduled preventative maintenance and safety checks on all ground fleet equipment.
- Record work performed on appropriate repair work order and maintenance records.
- Assist in maintaining and repairing a variety of company owned vehicles, including fuel truck, vans, passenger cars, and maintenance trucks and trailers.
- Assist the Pilots and Mechanics with other duties as assigned.
